The Teachers Association of Long Beach will be holding its election on March 31, 2010, through April 16, 2010, for the following offices:

TALB Officers:

- **Secretary (TALB Bylaws changed 2nd Vice-President position to Secretary.)**
- **Treasurer**

Nominations are open to all TALB members.

TALB Board Area Directors:

- **Lakewood Elementary**
- **Jordan Secondary**
- **Poly Secondary**
- **Wilson Secondary**
- **Millikan Elementary**

Nominations are open to TALB members who work in each area.

- **Minority-At-Large**

Nominations are open to all TALB members who are American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian/Pacific Islander, African American or Hispanic.

The term for each TALB office is from July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2012

Elections will also be held for the following:

- **3 CTA State Council Representatives**
- **1 CTA State Council Alternate**

Nominations are open to all TALB members.

The term for each CTA State Council Representative is 2010 – 2013. Runner-up becomes the elected State Council Alternate.

- **28 Delegates to the NEA Representative Assembly in New Orleans, LA**

Nominations are open to all TALB members to serve a single term for 2010. Elected delegates need to arrive on July 1st and depart July 6th.

Anyone wishing to run for office should file a **Declaration of Candidacy form** so that it is received by **Friday, March 5, 2010**, at the **TALB office, 4362 Atlantic Ave., Long Beach, CA 90807 no later than 4:30 PM** or at the **TALB Rep. Council meeting on February 23rd, by the end of the meeting.** Post-marked dates will not be accepted.

A candidate may submit a candidate statement. TALB Officers and Board of Directors are limited to 250 words. CTA State Council Representatives and NEA-RA local Delegates are limited to 25 words.
